Migrant and Seasonal Farmworkers (MSFW):

- Suffer from various chronic illnesses
- Experience barriers to care such as:
 - language differences
 - poverty and/or lack of insurance
 - frequent mobility
 - lack of familiarity or mistrust of the health care system

Mi VIA Project Outcomes

- To **improve the continuity of care** for patients across a multi-jurisdictional setting
- To **increase the patient's understanding** of their illness and treatment
- To **reduce the number of work days lost** to illness (for participating patients).
- To **improve patient's satisfaction** with the health care system
- To **demonstrate ease of use** among both patients and health care providers

- Improves worker access to care with community-based information links
- Cost efficient, user-friendly and addresses cultural and linguistic needs of workers

Mi Via Benefits


- Printable emergency card with photo ID identifies serious conditions, allergies, emergency contacts
- Personal email address provides permanent address that follows individual throughout life, providing a way to reach worker
- Scalable program with potential to be replicated on regional, statewide and even national level.


Phase I

- Enrolled 36 migrant workers at La Posada
- Increased to 250 MSFW 2003
- Provided classes and access to Internet
- Workers provided with free email account
- Use of Promotores for outreach and enrollment

Phase II

- Increasing enrollment to 2000 workers
- More than 40% are “family” accounts
- Software Upgrade
- Provider Portal






It is important to keep information on your health for you and your family. If you or a family member become ill, the doctor or clinic treating you must have the correct information to help make the most successful treatment for your medical condition.


It is important to be a partner with your doctor or clinic and to give the best information you can in order to get well or stay well. There are laws to protect your private information. The information you give your doctor is confidential and the doctor will not give that information to anyone without your permission.


You can help your doctor and yourself by keeping a record of your important health information including immunizations, allergies and any major health problems you are having now. Also tell the clinic if you have had serious medical problems in the past.


It is important to let the doctor or clinic know if you are taking medicines. This include herbs or other special treatments This is because some medicines can cause a bad reaction when taken with other types of drugs or medicines. This could even endanger your life. So always tell the clinic all the medicines you are taking.


























