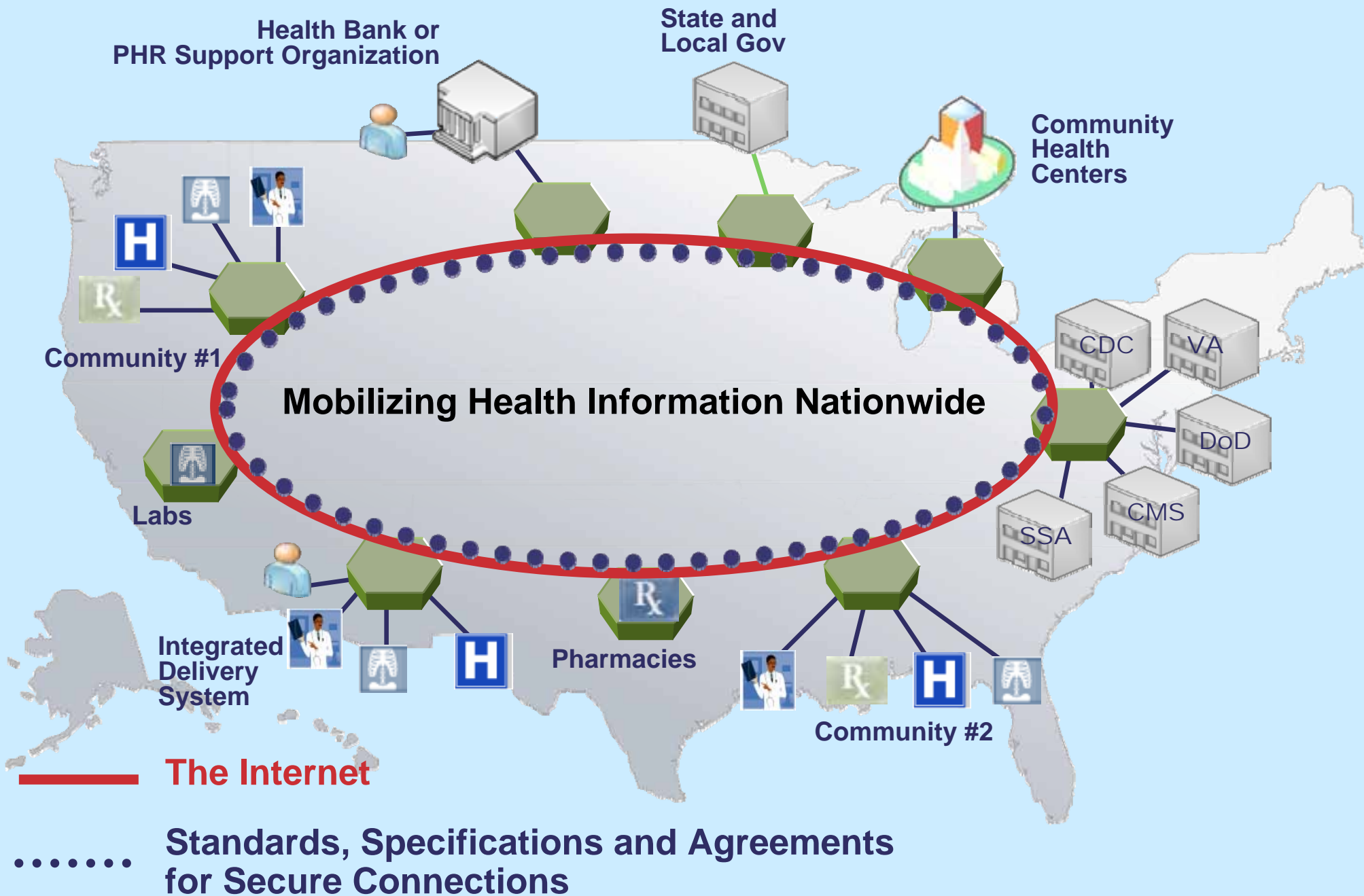

Common Network “Dial Tone”

Data and technical specifications:

- Provider has a patient but not their record:
 - 1 - Patient look-up and information retrieval
- Updating health data where it is needed:
 - 2 - Information routing and delivery
- Patient wants / doesn't want information to be electronically released:
 - 3 - The exchange of consumer preferences
- Providing the best care and protecting the population:
 - 4 - Support for population data uses
