## TITLE XIII—HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

SEC. 13001. SHORT TITLE; TABLE OF CONTENTS OF TITLE.




# Nationwide Health Information Network (NHIN) 2008 Forum Recap

- Discussed that NHIN has demonstrated Technical Capability

- Named the 20+ disparate organizations participating in the NHIN Cooperative

- Trial Implementations, which were closing out at that point
- Unveiled preparations for limited production in 2009


