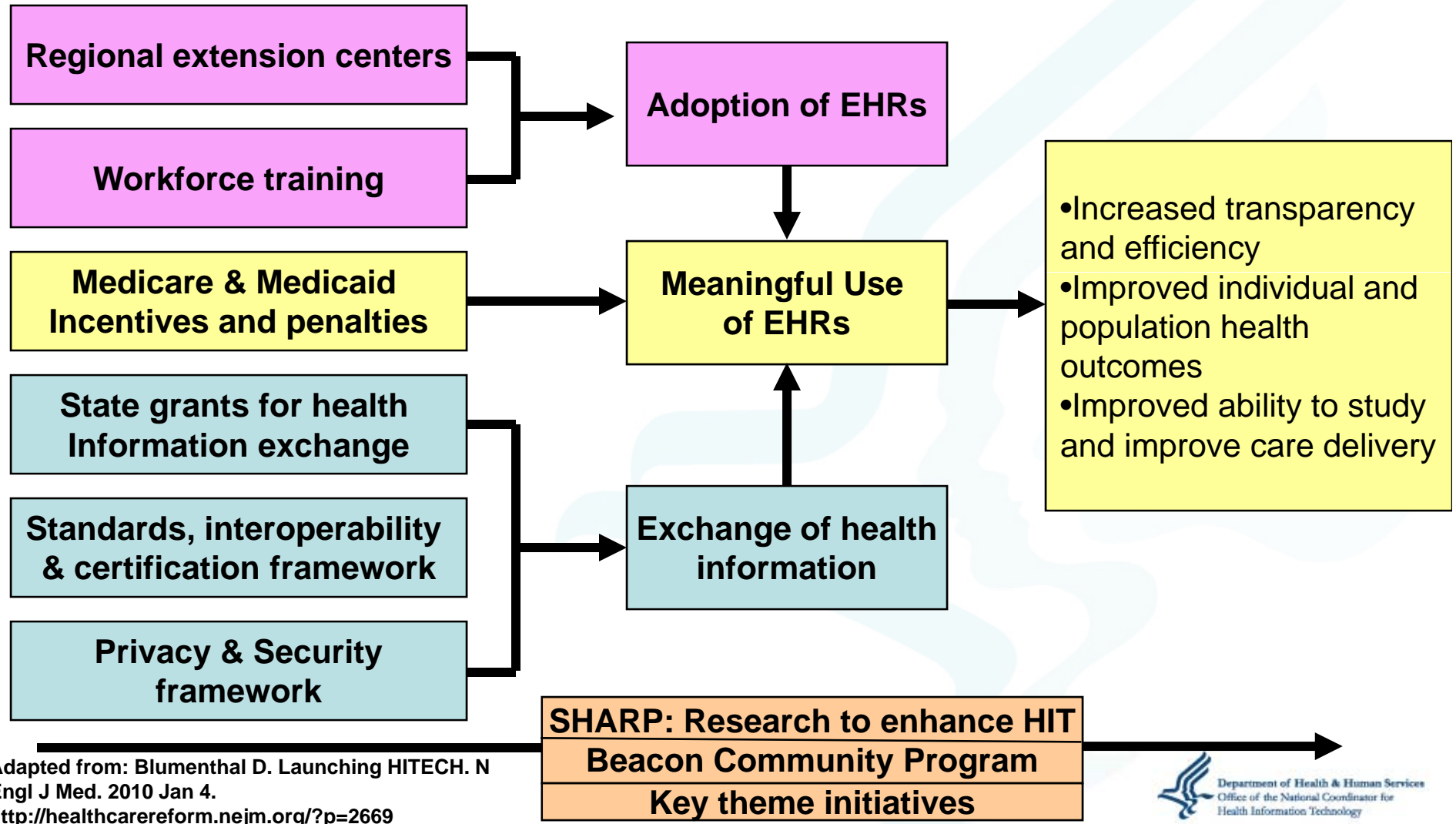

Some Highlights



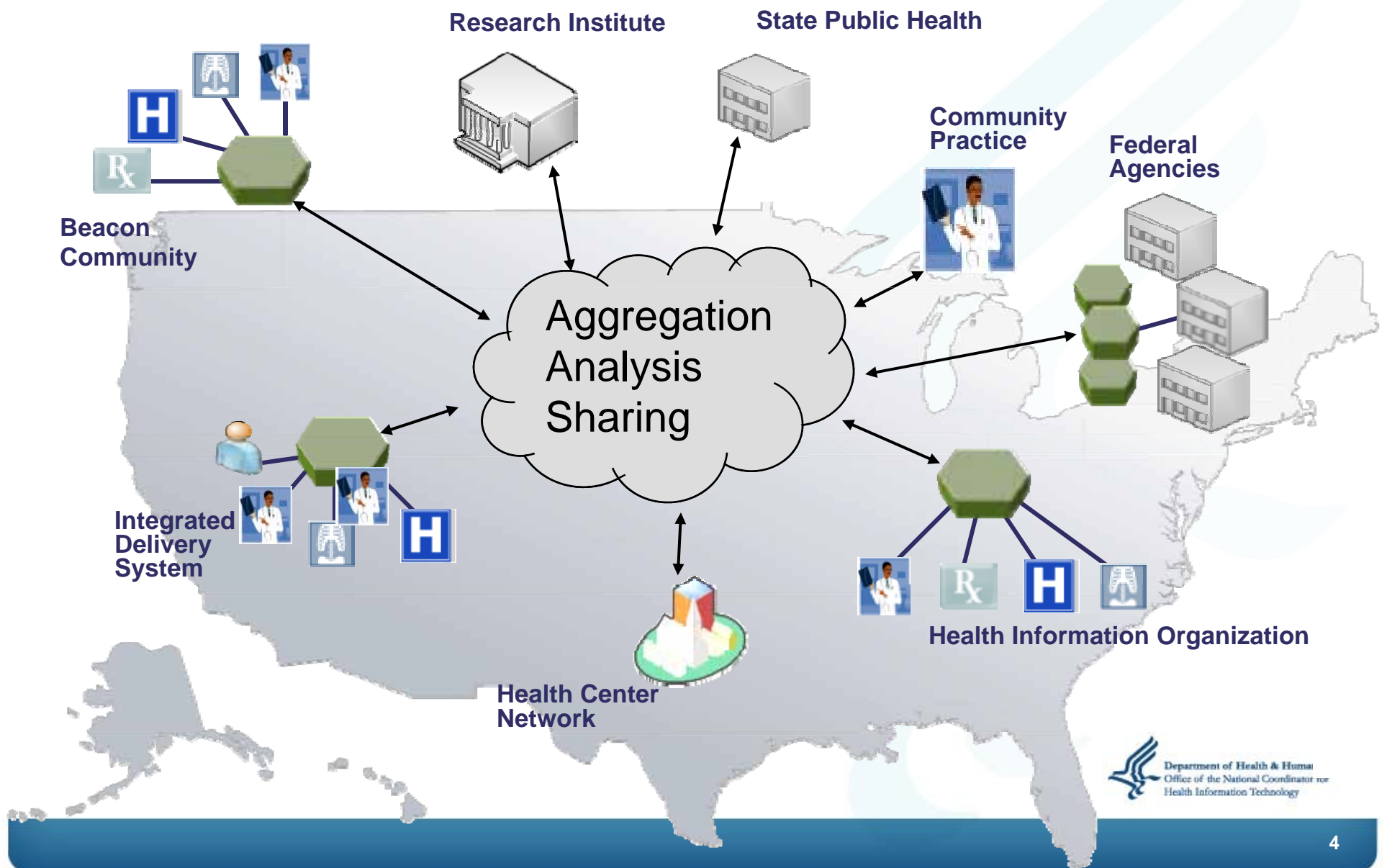
- Advisory committee work begun on MU Stages 2/3
 - Public workgroup meeting Dec 3
- Now 3 authorized testing and certification bodies (ATCBs)

- ONC grant programs in early implementation phase

IOM Learning System Definition



..one in which progress in science, informatics, and care culture align to generate new knowledge as an ongoing, natural by-product of the care experience, and seamlessly refine and deliver best practices for continuous improvement in health and health care.

IOM Workshop Series: “Digital Infrastructure for the Learning Health System”



Report (short version) in December:

- Foster a shared understanding of the vision for the digital infrastructure
- Explore current state of the system
- Identify priorities for future work
- Discuss the characteristics of potentially disruptive, breakthrough developments
- Consider strategy elements and priorities for accelerating progress

The Three Workshops



1. *Opportunities, Challenges, Priorities*

- Focus on overall vision and prominent issues and opportunities.

2. *The System After Next*

- Future-oriented deeper dive into areas identified during the first workshop.

3. *Strategy Scenarios*

- Reviewed common themes and extended into consideration of strategy elements, opportunities, responsibilities, and next steps.

- **Technical progress**
(Ultra Large Scale System Perspective)
- **Knowledge generation and use**
- **Patient and population engagement**
- **Governance**
