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
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Work Group Charge

Current State

- Selected data sets were presented to the WG
- Data sets inventory and uses compiled
- Supply side issues identified, e.g.
 - Frequency of access
 - Usability (technical and content)
 - For developers (e.g. taxonomy)
 - For unsophisticated users (e.g. data browsers)
 - What can we learn from current uses (Populations landscape)
- Demand side issues (*for discussion today*)
 - What are the needs
 - How to navigate resources
 - How to assess appropriateness of available data sets
