- Separate by stakeholder type
- Process criteria: how standard is the implementation?
 - Different states may have different interpretations, or make different decisions to comply

- Separate evaluation streams may work better
- RC could play a leading role in helping to estimate impact through an implementation review/proposed review virtuous cycle

- Call center volume that shows decrease in calls about issues addressed in operating rule
 - Should be compared against volume of calls about transactions/connectivity changes

What process(s) should be used to evaluate standards and operating rules?

- Quantify a baseline for the issue to be addressed by entity type
- Collect stakeholder input on evaluation criteria
- Fund data collection and lower stakes
 - States won't welcome additional reporting requirements
 - Will be difficult to get transparent data when too much is at stake (fines)
