Purpose

The Framework will offer a systematic approach to thinking, talking, and acting with respect to data.

The Framework Project has three goals:

- Develop an evolving set of data and method classification resources to help data experts support communities to systematically use data from all relevant sources to solve local problems;
- Generate recommendations for the Federal government and the data supplier ecosystem on high-impact gaps in data sources and methods identified through the Framework; and
- Catalyze development of interactive tools based on the Framework to support communities and others in optimal data use and learning.

These experts, and the systems they develop, will use its classification resources to help others work with data.
