



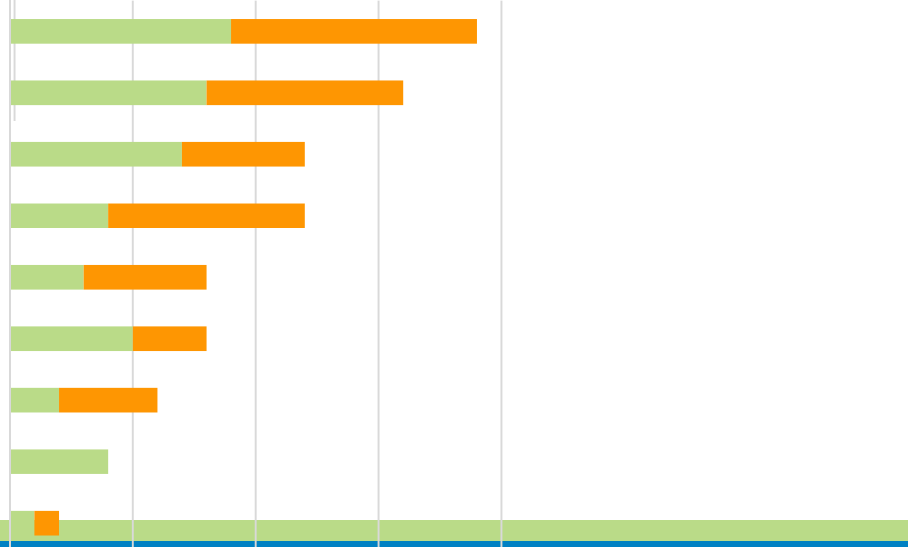
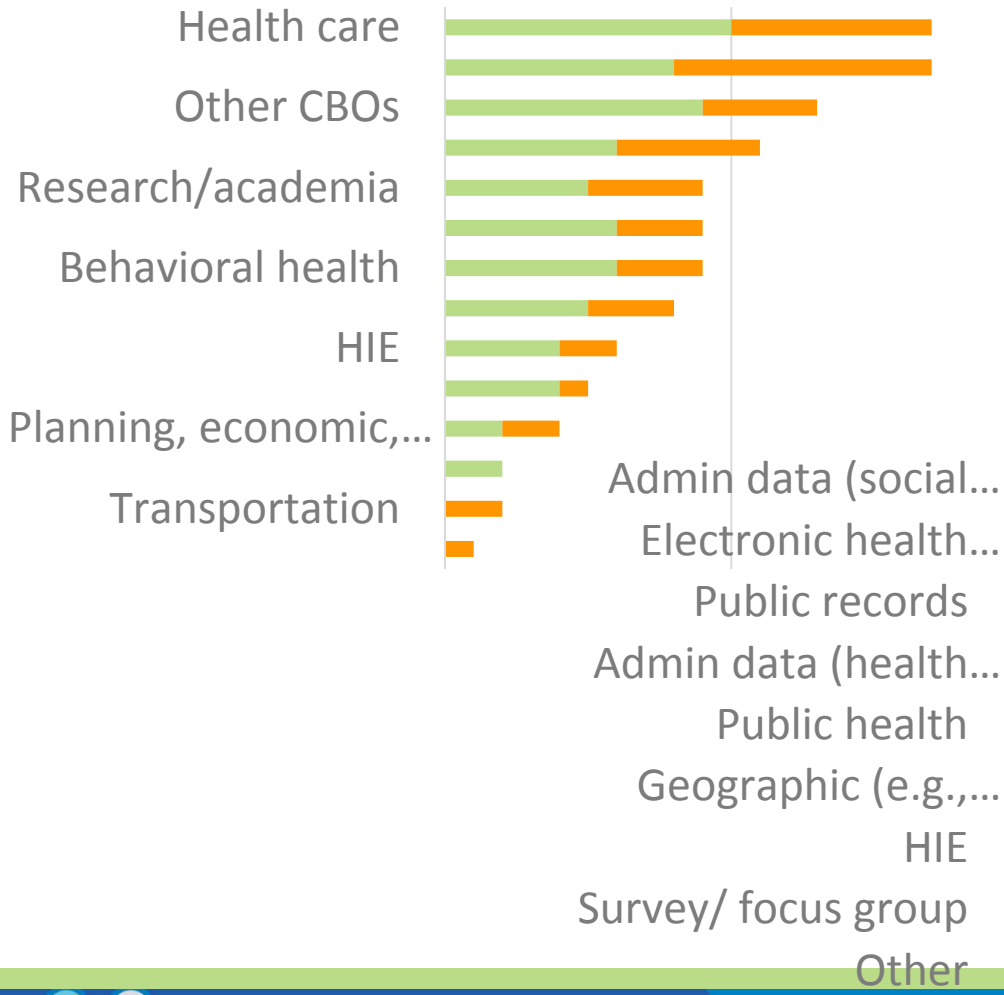
Community Health Peer Learning Program (CHP)
