

- Maintain transactions for claims, eligibility, prior auth etc
- Electronic Health Records, Attachments, clinical information, FHIR
- Pharmacy transactions electronic prescribing, eligibility for Rx
- Electronic Funds Transfer CCD+

#### What They Do

Dental Codes – Managed by the ADA

- Official source for the data elements & codes used in the electronic institutional claim transaction. Chaired by American Hospital Association
- Official source for data elements in professional claims. Chaired by American Medical Association with CMS as a partner.

## Administrative Procedures Act

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) establishes certain requirements which affect the adoption of standards, code sets and operating rules.

Federal agencies must:

- publish a notice of proposed rulemaking,
- provide the public an opportunity to comment on the proposal, and
- publish a final rule with a statement of the rule's purpose and basis.

There are exceptions, including the opportunity to publish Interim Final Rule with comment, good cause exceptions, direct final rule making and consolidated public comments.
