I am writing to extend my sincere appreciation to you and all the members of the National Committee on Vital and Health Statistics (NCVHS) for the recommendations submitted to the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) earlier this month on the de-identification of protected health information under HIPAA. De-identification is a critical tool for protecting individuals' privacy while still enabling uses of health information to improve individual and population health.

The Department greatly appreciates the effort put forth by NCVHS at your May 2016 hearing and in your subsequent deliberations.
