X12 Requests to Review HIPAA Transactions



- X12 has requested NCVHS review of 4 updated transaction implementation guides:
 - Claims (837 Professional, Institutional and Dental Claims
 - 2021 CAQH Index adoption rates: 97% (Medical) and 84% (Dental)
 - Payment/Remittance Advice (835)
 - 2021 CAQH Index adoption rates: 76% (Medical) and 84% (Dental)
- Move from Version 5010 to Version 8020
 - 5010 was balloted by X12 in 2003, adopted under HIPAA by CMS in 2009 and implemented by industry in 2012
 - 8020 was balloted by X12 in 2020

ICD-11 Status



- ICD-11 adopted by World Health Organization May 25, 2019, to be effective beginning January 1, 2022.
- Three components
 - Mortality
 - Morbidity for U.S. health care and public health
 - Morbidity for U.S. health care billing and payment
- NCVHS recommended that HHS:
 - Conduct research on how ICD-11 would meet U.S. needs; and
 - Develop a communications plan to avoid mistakes made in ICD-10 adoption

ICD-11 Status



• HHS has acknowledged the NCVHS recommendations

- Some research done within NIH/NLM
 - Presented to NCVHS March 2021 by Dr. Kin-Wah Fung
- Additional insight from Robert Anderson in March 2022

• Recent subcommittee conversations with CMS/OBRHI

- OBRHI/DNS exploring availability of resources
- Subcommittee collaboration with OBRHI, other agencies and private sector on research design and industry/expert convenings
- Subcommittee objectives unchanged: vet ICD-11 (including potential Clinical Modification); research and communications plan; and avoid repeat of ICD-10 implementation dysfunction

ICD-11 Status in Other Countries



• Canada

- Work underway to assess transitioning to ICD-11 with consideration to timelines required for implementation. Do not currently have a timeframe for ICD-11 implementation.
- Currently assessing the level of specificity captured in Canada and whether a Canadian version of ICD-11 is required.

• Australia

- Has not made any formal decisions to move to ICD-11
- Whether a national modification is required is still under consideration
- The answer to that will likely inform the decision to implement and target date for implementation
- Have an ICD-11 Task Force to consider the issues of a national modification and other issues
