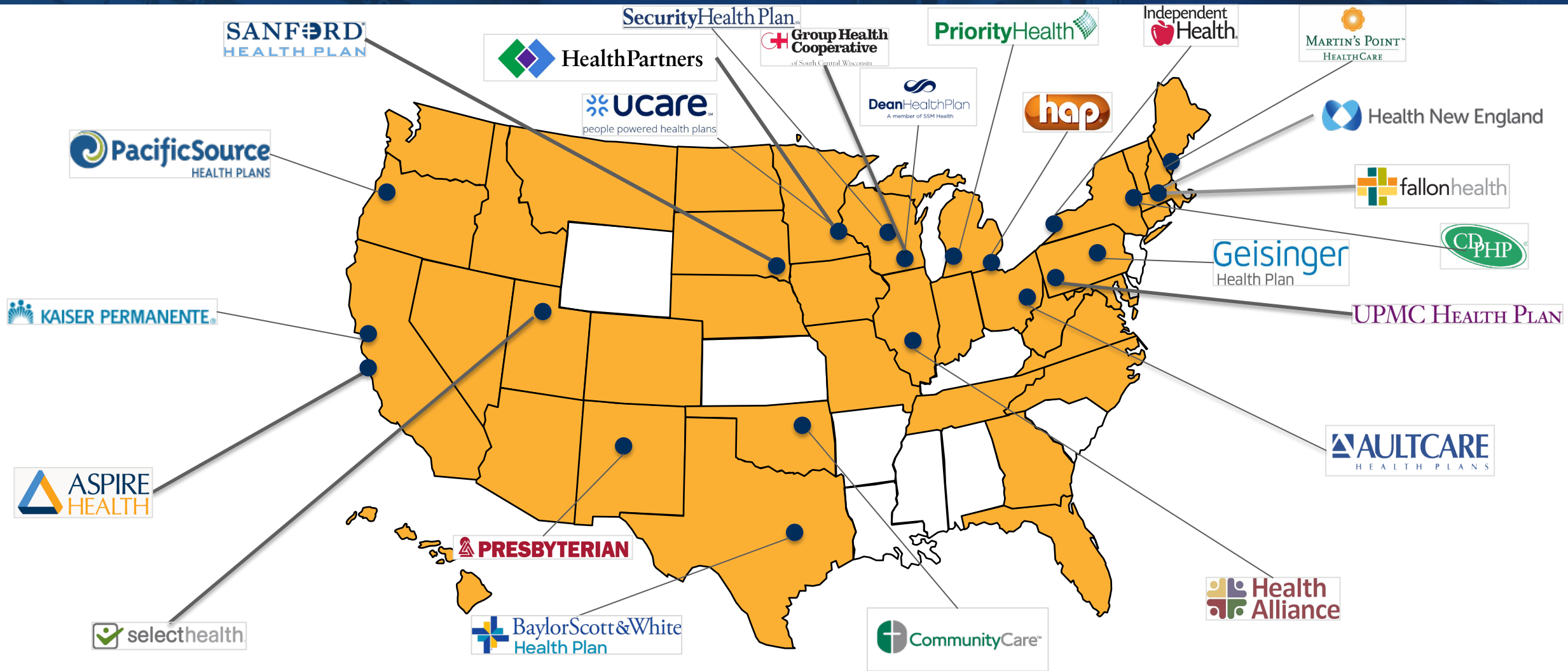


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States with an ACHP Plan

ACHP General Feedback on X12 Updates

ACHP Position: We are generally supportive of the X12 Standard Transactions proposals.

Costs

- Significant lift for plans when completed in conjunction with other interoperability efforts
 - Will vary based on plan readiness and resources available for small plans in particular

Timeline

- Concerns about interaction with Attachments and ePrior Authorization Interoperability Proposed Rules
 - Attachment Standards implementation: mid to late 2025
 - ePrior Authorization & Interoperability implementation: January 1, 2026
- Looking forward to consistent, rolling updates of the 8020 version and implementation guides

ACHP Feedback on Specifics of X12 Updates

FHIR Crosswalks:

- Mixed reactions to transition to FHIR due to lack of maturity

Alternative Payment Models and VBP

- Potential benefits on the remittance side for gradual improvements to VBP arrangement processes

Diagnosis Codes

- Appreciate the increased number of diagnosis code fields to accommodate SDOH codes

Proposal-Specific Comments

- Member plans are supportive of the Unique Device Identifier
- Member plans are wary of FHIR-crosswalks, particularly as there is more variations in the resources smaller plans have available
