Report to Congress in Statute



- Responsible generally for <u>advising the Secretary and the Congress</u> on the status of the implementation of part C of title XI of the Social Security Act.
- Assists and advises the Secretary <u>in complying with</u> the requirements imposed under Part C of Title XI of the Social Security Act.
- Studies the issues related to the adoption of uniform data standards for patient medical record information and the electronic interchange of such information, <u>and report to the Secretary recommendations and</u> <u>legislative proposals</u> for such standards and electronic exchange.




...shall address the following subjects, to the extent that the Committee determines appropriate:

- The extent to which persons required to comply with Part C of the Act are cooperating in implementing the standards adopted under such part;
- The extent to which such entities are meeting the security standards adopted under such part and the types of penalties assessed for noncompliance with such standards;
- Whether the federal and State Governments are receiving information of sufficient quality to meet their responsibilities under such part;
- Any problems that exist with respect to implementation of such part;
- The extent to which timetables under such part are being met.

2021 Report: Evolving Context for Health Information Policy-Five Major Trends in Health Information



- New technologies, platforms, and models for managing health information—with varying degrees of maturity and implementation—have emerged to meet pressing business needs. Patients' roles in accessing and using their health data have expanded and evolved.
- 2. Patients' roles in accessing and using their health data have expanded and evolved. The COVID-19 pandemic has exposed grave weaknesses in the public health information infrastructure.
- The convergence of clinical and administrative data standards is gaining recognition and crossing the boundaries of traditional data and program silos.
- 4. The COVID-19 pandemic has exposed critical weaknesses in the public health information infrastructure.
- 5. Health information privacy and security challenges have proliferated.
